Once we receive your completed application, you will be contacted with your line up number and time of arrival at the Old Union Hosiery Mill (Current GA Xtracts). Parade begin time is 2:00 p.m.

All participants must complete the parade route before dismantling your group or float. The route goes from Union Hosiery Mill, right onto South Hillard Street, right onto Lamb Avenue, right onto Boyd Street at the fire department and back to GA Xtracts.

As a warning, if you choose to throw candy, please throw it as far as possible. Children get very excited and are often not aware of the dangers of a moving vehicle. We would like to avoid any injuries.

The driver of the vehicle must be at least 21 years old and possess a legal driver's license. One adult, over the age of 18 years, must accompany each group of 10 students with each entry. Drivers may not tailgate or leave gaps of more than 3 car lengths between entries. If you use pets in your entry, they must be on leashes and you must clean up after your animal, horses included.
