## CITY OF UNION POINT SPRING PROPERTY CLEANING PICK-UP BEGINS MAY 22, 2023

The City of Union Point will be holding its annual "Spring Clean-Up" in May. We ask that you place discarded household and yard items along the street in front of your home for pick-up the weekend before pick-up begins. All items must be out for pick-up by the morning of May 22nd. The city workers will only make one trip down each street so please make sure to place all items along the roadside before 7:30 a.m. on May 22nd. Your cooperation will be appreciated.

A large roll-off bin will also be located and monitored at 211 South Hilliard Street May 22<sup>nd</sup> through 28th for use by <u>Union Point Citizens</u> if you would prefer to place items in the roll-off yourselves. <u>DO NOT BRING TIRES OR UNAUTHORIZED ITEMS TO THIS BIN.</u>

<u>NOTE</u>: There <u>will not be a bin for tires</u> this year. PLEASE <u>DO NOT PLACE TIRES</u> ALONG THE ROADSIDE FOR PICK-UP.

The City <u>WILL NOT pick up or dispose of the following unauthorized items</u> if they are placed by the road:

- Building Materials (Roofing Materials/Shingles, Metal, etc.)
- Heavy Consumer Durables/Appliances (i.e.: Dish Washers, A/C or Heating Units)
- Household Garbage
- Hazardous or Industrial Waste (Oil, Batteries, Paint Cans, Tires)

<u>AGAIN</u>: Please <u>DO NOT PLACE THE ABOVE-MENTIONED ITEMS</u> beside the road to be picked up. The city will not pick up these items.

## ITEMS AUTHORIZED TO BE PICKED UP INCLUDE:

 Relatively lightweight electronic consumer durables/appliances (TVs, radios, digital media players, microwaves, coffee makers, computers, collegiate refrigerators, etc.); Furniture (chairs, sofas, cushions, mattresses, tables, lawn furniture, water hoses, children's outdoor toys, bicycles, plastic or resin planters, resin trash bins, coolers)

REMINDER: ALL HOME AND PROPERTY OWNERS ARE ASKED TO KEEP LAWNS MOWED AND MAINTAINED. LET'S KEEP OUR COMMUNITY CLEAN AND MORE ATTRACTIVE FOR THOSE WHO CALL UNION POINT HOME.
