This position is skilled technical work in the operation, maintenance and repair of water purification plant equipment and facilities. Responsibilities include, but are not limited to conducting tests on a variety of water samples, safe and efficient operation of pumps and filtration equipment with limited supervision; monitoring and adjusting chemical feeders; daily record keeping logs of water consumption and chemicals utilized; testing devices and equipment for proper water treatment, orders chemicals, prepares reports and water samples as required by the State of Georgia.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS:

High School Diploma or equivalent with supplemental courses related to chemistry or water analysis; onsite training and State of Georgia certification is required. The ability to read meters, charts and graphs and record data is necessary. Experience in water-plant operations or maintenance is a plus.

Must possess a valid driver's license with an excellent driver's history.

Must have a stable employment history.

Must be able to perform the essential functions of the job.

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS AND WORK ENVIRONMENT:

Ability to understand and follow complex oral and written instructions and work under limited supervision. Ability to read meters, charts, and graphs to record and compile accurate data for records and reporting. Lift heavy supplies (up to 50 pounds) and perform other similar actions during the course of the workday.
