

WORK SESSION MEETING OF MAYOR AND COUNCIL: OCTOBER 3, 2017

The City Council of Union Point met in a work session on Tuesday, October 3, 2017, at 10:00 A.M., in the Four-Room School Building, at 211 Veazey Street, with Mayor Heidbrider presiding. The members present were Linda Barrington, Bill Callaway, Sylvester Johnson, and Janie Watts. Nancy Lowry was absent.

Mayor Heidbrider opened with prayer.

Mayor Heidbrider asked for a motion to approve the agenda. Ms. Watts made a motion to approve the agenda. Seconded by Mr. Johnson. The motion passed unanimously.

Council reviewed the amended FY 2017 budgets. Mayor Heidbrider called for a motion to approve and adopt the first reading of the amended FY 2017 Budget Ordinance. Mr. Johnson made a motion to approve and adopt the first reading of the Amended FY 2017 Budget Ordinance. Seconded by Mrs. Watts. There was an opportunity for discussion. The motion passed unanimously.

Mr. Jackson reviewed the proposed FY 2018 budgets with the Mayor and Council.

Mr. Jackson discussed with the Mayor and Council the tax millage rate. The rate for 2016 taxes was 9.799 mills. The Mayor and Council were in agreement to set the tax millage rate at 9.862 mills for 2017.

An executive session was not needed.

Mayor Heidbrider adjourned the meeting and asked Mr. Johnson to close the meeting in prayer.
